Marriage: Contact parish office no less than six months prior to wedding date.


Sacrament of Anointing of Sick: Please contact us before a surgery, during hospitalization or if experiencing a change in health.

Since last September I have been meeting regularly with 13 children and their parents.

We meet to explore and learn about the sacraments of Reconciliation and Confirmation and Holy Eucharist. We explore what they mean and why they are important to our everyday lives. We learn that sacraments are not just a "Sunday" thing but have relevance to all we think and do in our daily life. The sacraments help shape who we are.

We also learn that sacraments are mysteries. We will never understand them completely. They are mysteries not to be solved but instead to be received as loving gifts from our Lord. They nurture our faith and heal and restore us.

It is a delight to work with these children. Their comments and questions and serious sincerity are renewing to my faith too. All of them have gone to Reconciliation. They will be confirmed on Saturday, April 22 at 1:00pm at St. Mary Church, Alma, of Nativity of the Lord Parish. Their first Holy Eucharist will be on Sunday, May 7 here at St. Vincent. Please pray for them and let them know you are thinking of them and happy for them to be joining the rest of the parish family in these important ways. Their names are below.
