Marriage: Contact parish office no less than six months prior to wedding date.


Sacrament of Anointing of Sick: Please contact us before a surgery, during hospitalization or if experiencing a change in health.

Today is first Eucharist for Gabriel Hoppe, Tommy Mikek, and Danika Redes. Next Sunday Eddie Radtke will receive his first Eucharist. A few weeks ago they all had Confirmation and before that they did their first Reconciliation. Please take a moment to tell the children how happy you are for them to be part of our church family in this special way.

Children gather their faith from many places. The first and most important is at home from their families. But there is also a time and place for more structured formation. That is what Sacramental preparation and Faith formation classes do.

As they prepare for Reconciliation they learn about the gift of forgiveness and the fact we can be forgiven over and over again. Although children are limited in their life experience and not able to process theology as adults, they do understand the concrete reality of feelings and actions. They know that sometimes they say and do things that hurt others, and others do such things to them. To accept forgiveness and learn how to forgive others is an ongoing part of our spiritual life that begins for them at first Reconciliation.

At Confirmation they become more aware of the Holy Spirit and learn that the Spirit is real and can cause things to happen. It is a helper and guide and is always with them. They learn that that we must be willing to hear and follow the Spirit.

They learn to experience Holy Eucharist as food for our soul and body. They learn that Eucharist gives us strength to go through life and helps us grow in faith and love. These milestones are some of the most important in their lives and we are so happy to acknowledge them.


