

I have a niece, who when she was young would cry a lot, most of the time for no apparent reason. Not just little sobs but wailing more like a siren than a whimper. Once, in the midst of her crying, her Mom asked why it was that she was crying. Interspersed with sobs she replied "Because it feels good"
