Marriage: Contact parish office no less than six months prior to wedding date.


Sacrament of Anointing of Sick: Please contact us before a surgery, during hospitalization or if experiencing a change in health.



In fact, until I was given a framed picture from that night as a gift for my ordination, I didn't have a picture to remember it by. I have been to almost every Easter Vigil at St Mary/Nativity of the Lord since that day. Celebrating that special vigil, and seeing the looks on other people's faces, keeps that night close to my heart. I am looking forward to making new memories, and celebrating here at St Vincent de Paul Parish this year.

A special part of that liturgy is that it begins in darkness. In fact the 3rd paragraph in the rubrics for **The Easter Vigil in the Holy Night** states "The entire celebration of the Easter Vigil must take place during the night, so that it begins after nightfall and ends before daybreak on the Sunday". I promise you the Vigil will not go on until daybreak. Next week I will share a little more regarding the first part of the Vigil, The Blessing of the Fire and Preparation of the Candle.
