Hospitalized/Homebound Ministry: Please call the office to arrange for Eucharist or for a pastoral visit.



I would like to share a few words regarding the Parish Mission and the Helping Hands Food packing event. As mentioned earlier, the Mission is 3 days, Sunday, Monday and Tuesday evening. Each evening will be unique and stands on its own. If for some reason you couldn't make it on Sunday evening, Tuesday and Wednesday would be just as fruitful. Please make it a priority to make it to at least one evening.

I would also like encourage everyone to invite a friend, a neighbor, or someone who hasn't been to Mass in a while. This is the type of event that is easy to welcome someone, or welcome someone back to. When you invite them, let them know what day(s) you are going, and even consider offering them a ride. This is a great opportunity to let our hospitality at St. Vincent de Paul Parish shine.

Finally, regarding the food packing event, a few people have asked where the food is coming from. Rise Against Hunger, which is the organization that handles the logistics for Catholic Relief Services, brings all the materials. We supply the space, the tables, and most importantly, the hands. Teams will be packing nutrient packs, dehydrated vegetables, dehydrated soy and rice into heat sealable bags. Other teams will be weighing, adjusting and sealing the bags, while other teams box the meals, tape and stack the boxes. The social hall will be a beehive of activity.

Thank you for all that you do, for the parish, the community and the world, in the name of Christ.
