Hospitalized/Homebound Ministry: Please call the office to arrange for Eucharist or for a pastoral visit.



Collection for the Archdiocese of the Military This national collection is taken up this weekend Envelopes for donations are in our entries.

The Archdiocese for the Military Services provides a full range of pastoral and spiritual ministries to those in the Armed Forces. Currently, there are 285 Catholic military chaplains providing care to over 1.8 million Catholics on ships, in combat, on bases, and in 153 VA hospitals. This collection supports them and helps fund their co-sponsored Seminarian Program, now educating 30 men. The Archdiocese of the Military does not receive funding from the military or government and relies on private donors and this triennial collection.
