

Supporting Our Food Pantry Meijer's Simply Give Campaign Goes to Jan. 4

Thanks to generous customers and a strong commitment to Food Pantries, this campaign has generated more than \$50 million for more than 400 food pantries throughout the Midwest since November 2008.

How does it work? Simply Give cards are available at Meijer, Mt. Pleasant, and in our entries. Each card must be paid for (\$10) at a Meijer checkout. At the end of the campaign, Meijer gift cards will be issued to our parish to shop for our food pantry. This year our parish may use also these cards for diapers.

And, there are two bonus days! If you purchase one of these \$10 cards on Double Match Days (Tuesday, December 3 and Friday, December 13) your \$10 card purchase will be matched by Meijer so that your gift becomes \$20.

New this year is an optional social media component. Until Nov. 28 you can share a photo of your meal with the hashtag #MeijerSimplyGive and Meijer will donate a meal to a family in need.
