Dear Friends in Christ,

Being welcoming and inviting to our faith is a key part of our Christian identity. Jesus' last words in the Gospel of Matthew remind us of this.

Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age.

We cannot do any of the above without welcoming the stranger first. Our first thought when someone is sitting in "our" pew should not be what are you doing in my seat but rather I am so happy to see you. Sitting somewhere different at Mass can provide new perspective and a new neighbor in the pew. When we welcome those around us at the beginning of Mass, if you don't know the person's name, ask them. You can start by sharing your own name. It is okay if you forgot someone's name from before, not everyone is great at remembering names. Personally, I am horrible at it.

Next weekend the diocese is hosting an event "HOW TO SHARE YOUR FAITH IN DAILY LIFE (If you're nervous...fear not!)". You can register through the Diocesan website <a href="mailto:saginaw.org">saginaw.org</a>, or 989-797-6608. Cost is \$10; does not include lunch. I have met one of the presenters before and he is excellent, and we are looking into one of his in-depth programs for our parish..

I would like to offer a small hint on sharing your faith. This Saturday or Sunday, as you walk out the door of the church into mission territory, as you are humming a few bars of the closing hymn, remember where your smile is. It is right there on your face. Keep it there this week. Do not pack it away into your heart where you keep your faith and love of God. Wear it so that everyone you meet can see it. Then your smile becomes the doorway to the treasure of your faith and love.
