

Dear Friends in Christ,

As I stated previously in my last message, we face a challenging time in our global society. As people of faith we are called, not to despair but rather, to place our concerns and our hope in a loving and merciful God. As medical professionals, scientists and government officials continue to meet and formulate responses to the Coronavirus pandemic, we must prepare ourselves for sacrifices. In the midst of this current medical emergency, there are still the everyday medical emergencies that occur. Our social sacrifice made now, is not just for our own family's sake but for the good of others, ensuring that medical care is available for all who need it. The following is in keeping with guidelines given to us by Bishop Gruss. The guidelines may be found on the diocesan website *www.saginaw.org.* 

1. All public Masses, Liturgy of the Word and Communion services, Christian Mediation, Stations of the Cross services, Taizé and Communal Penance services are suspended.

2. All faith formation classes, for K-12 and adult, all bible studies and other public gatherings at St. Vincent de Paul for educational purposes are suspended.

3. Due to the cancellation of Mass on the Memorial of St. Patrick, March 17th at St. Patrick Church we will celebrate a votive Mass for the patron Saint of the Church sometime later this year. We will choose an open date in the liturgical calendar after the suspension of Masses is lifted. We look forward to Wednesday, March 17<sup>th</sup>, 2021 when we can celebrate the Memorial of St. Patrick on the proper date.

4. St. Vincent de Paul church will remain open daily for private prayer from 9:00am-12:00pm & 6:00pm-8:00pm. There is hand sanitizer at the main entrance to use upon entrance to and exit from the church. If you have not been feeling well physically, please, for the safety of all, pray from home.

As I mentioned on Sunday, please take a few minutes out of your day in the coming weeks, to open your parish directory and call a fellow parishioner. Share a moment or two together, knowing that even if there are miles and walls between each other physically, you are bound together in Christ. And continue to keep in mind and prayer those who are currently fighting this disease, the patients themselves as well as the nurses and doctors and all other health care personnel and first responders.

O God, who chose the Bishop Saint Patrick to preach your glory to the peoples of Ireland, grant, through his merits and intercession, that those who glory in the name of Christian may never cease to proclaim your wondrous deeds to all. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever.
