
Sacrament of Anointing of Sick: Please contact us before a surgery, during hospitalization or if experiencing a change in health.

Excerpts From a Letter From Our Diocese

Our celebration of the Chrism Mass this year will take place at St. Thomas Aquinas Church on Tuesday, September 15 at 10:30am. Bishop Gruss will be the presider and homilist at the Eucharist, bless the Oils of the Sick and Catechumens, and consecrate the Sacred Chrism.

Given our current COVID-19 restrictions, the Chrism Mass will look substantially different from past years. This year, provisional vessels will be both prepared and provided for each parish and Catholic institution to transport the Holy Oils back to your parish or institution.

The Holy Oils will then be properly distributed in the parish's own appropriately cleaned vessels. They are not to be comingled with last year's oils. Last year's oils will be reverently repackaged and returned to our Office of Liturgy for proper burial in consecrated ground.

Pastors and Pastoral Administrators may only invite two (2) people from each parish to attend this year's Chrism Mass. Rules for masks and social distancing will be in effect.
