## TWENTY-SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME





Dear Friends in Christ,

When we were in Colorado, most of my time on my phone each evening was spent seeking out where we would go hiking the next day. One day Erin and I spent visiting the Mother Cabrini Shrine outside Golden, CO. The shrine sits on the side of Lookout Mountain which is in the foothills of the Rockies.

At the highest point on the property, which began as a girl's summer camp for Queen of Heaven Orphanage run by the Sisters of the Sacred Heart, is a 22 foot statue of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. At the base of the statue is a representation of the Sacred Heart formed by stones. It is encased in metal and glass, for the work was done by Mother Cabrini and her sisters on her last visit to Golden, CO.

There are 373 steps that wind their way along the hillside to the summit, seen along the tree line. The right side of the stairway on your way up is flanked by the Stations of the Cross, and then the Joyful, Sorrowful and Glorious mysteries of the Rosary.

What stands out to me more than anything, it how easy it is for us to find testaments to our faith when traveling. Whether it's a unique shrine, a beautiful, ornate cathedral, or a simple church built by a faithful community, our faith permeates the landscape of our county.

When you travel, take a moment to seek out something great, and spend a few moments with God.
