Hospitalized/Homebound Ministry: Please call the office to arrange for Eucharist or for a pastoral visit.



There are 4 different versions of the Stewardship Little Books, each based on one of the four Gospels. Last week we handed out copies of the books based on the Gospel of Matthew. We have more available in case you didn't get one last week. Ask an usher and they will help you get a copy.

The final words of my talk at the end of mass were a paraphrase of the first page of the Stewardship book in light of the Gospel of John. The words are so fitting they bear repeating.

## What is Stewardship?

- Stewardship is a way of life based on the Gospel. How do I make it my way of life?
- I take to heart the opening words of Psalm 24: "The earth is the Lord's and all that is in it."
- I recognize that part of my God-given make-up is a need to give, and that it is a source of my own peace and happiness.
- I return a portion of my time/skill and possessions to God in a spirit of gratitude.
- I decide on a planned and consistent way of doing this.
- I take it off the top, rather than what is left over.
