

St. Vincent de Paul Pastoral and Finance Council Meeting Minutes- June 18, 2020

Members of the Pastoral and Finance Councils met via Zoom for a joint meeting which began at 6:07pm. Present were: Deacon Todd Lovas, Kaylie Willoughby, Bill Daniels, Dave Spindler, Craig Shanteau, Tom Moomey, Zack Lobsinger, Jackie Loomis, Liz Bacon, Sue Stonebrook, Judy Moldenhauer and Tim Sieracki. The meeting was called to order and Deacon Todd led the opening prayer.

New Business: Zack reviewed the proposed parish budget for 2020-2021; it was approved as presented with support from Tom Moomey and Jackie Loomis. Deacon Todd reported per diocesan guidelines rental agreements for St. Vincent and St. Patrick's parish halls are being suspended this summer due to COVID-19. Deacon Todd reported on attendance from the last 2 Sunday masses and gained input on the need to have Joyce continue registering parishioners since we are not getting close to the maximum 70 persons per mass. COVID-19 guidelines will continue including all those over age 2 wearing masks and sanitation of the church after weekday and weekend masses. At this time Holy Communion cannot be taken outside of the church to be distributed to those who cannot safely attend mass. We discussed use of the parking lot and parish hall for overflow and adding in the Saturday 4:30pm mass to the weekly schedule. Deacon Todd reported that parishioners can choose to be taken off the OSV list if they no longer wish to receive tithing envelopes by contacting the parish office. Members reviewed the May 21 meeting minutes and they were approved as presented with support from Tom Moomey and Liz Bacon.

The meeting concluded with a closing prayer at 7:16pm.
