Funerals: Please contact us before or after contacting the funeral home.





Dear Friends in Christ,

I have been thinking a lot about where my identity as a Christian is in my life, and how it impacts the rest of my life. When Steven Angrisano was here for our Parish Mission in 2019, he spoke about the need for God to be at the top of the pyramid of our life. The pyramid, or any building for that matter, weight is transferred down through the structure until is rests on stable ground. Another way of looking at it is that anything at the top the makes its weight felt on that which is below via gravity.

When God is at the top of our life pyramid and faith is put first, then everything else in our lives is ordered towards our faith. When God is replaced at the top, by work or hobbies, the structure becomes unbalanced. Even something good and wholesome, like our family or our marriage, needs to be under our relationship with God. If I place my marriage above God, then I am likely to define my relationship with God in terms of my marriage, instead of viewing my marriage in terms of God which is good and proper.

Another way of saying this is, everything I am should begin with "I am a Christian", everything else is at least secondary to that fact. Before I am a husband and father, before I am a son, before I am a Godfather or uncle or nephew or cousin, before I am American of Hungarian descent, before I am a member of any political party or club, before I am a Michigander or Flyfisher: I am a Christian. In fact, even before I am Deacon Todd, I am a disciple of Christ.

Loving God, I am your disciple this day and always, help me begin there, so that everything else in my life may be ordered according to your will.
