Hospitalized/Homebound Ministry: Please call the office to arrange for Eucharist or for a pastoral visit.



Stewardship: Food for Thought

Jesus said, "Amen, amen, I say to you, you are looking for me not because you saw signs but because you ate the loaves and were filled. You should not be working for perishable food but for the food that remains unto life eternal." (*Jn* 6:26-27)

When they saw him feed 5,000 people with just a couple of loaves, they said, "Teach us how to do God's works." They wanted to do what was sensational too. They missed the point of it all. "Everything I have," Jesus said, "comes from God, my Father." It was never, "Look at what *I'm* doing... Look at how great *I am*." Instead, " I have come to do my Father's will." Whether he was doing something great or small, he always sought to do the will of the Father. That was the point of it all.
