Blessings dear friends in Christ.

Holy Week is almost here as move through these final days in Lent. As we prepare to celebrate Palm Sunday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, the Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday, we call to mind Jesus's triumphant entry into Jerusalem, the institution of the Eucharist, Jesus' Passion, Death and Resurrection. We seek to understand more fully, the meaning of the Paschal Mystery.

Although these celebrations will be much more like normal than how we celebrated last year, there will still be marked differences which I want to take a moment to inform you about.

Palm Sunday

There will not be a procession from the social hall. Palms will be blessed at the beginning of the Mass and distributed by ushers following Mass.

Holy Thursday (April 1, 7:00pm)

The optional rite of washing of the feet will take place with Fr. Fred and Deacon Todd washing each other's feet. The tabernacle of reservation will be in the social hall this year. As always, we depart in silence.

Good Friday (April 2, 12:00 noon)

Adoration of the Holy Cross will take place without contact, by simple genuflection or bow. The traffic pattern will follow that of our procession to Eucharist, returning to pews in the usual manner. As always, we depart in silence.

Easter Vigil (April 3, 8:30pm)

Due to the need to lower masks and blow forcibly to extinguish candles we will not be using congregational candles this year. There will not be a procession to the font by the congregation following the baptisms. In its place will be a sprinkling rite.

I look forward to seeing you these at the these sacred and special liturgies.
