Funerals: Please contact us before or after contacting the funeral home.





Wasting Time with God: Liturgy of the Hours - Part 2

The basic cycle of the Liturgy of the Hours follows the chart below.

Name of Hour	Traditional Name	Traditional Time	Major/Minor Hour
Office of Readings	Matins	First Hour	Major
Morning Prayer	Lauds	6:00AM	Major
Midmorning Prayer	Terce	9:00AM	minor
Midday Prayer	Sext	Noon	minor
Afternoon Prayer	None	3:00PM	minor
Evening Prayer	Vespers	6:00PM	Major
Night Prayer	Compline	9:00PM	minor

Whether one begins the day with the Office of Readings or with Morning Prayer, it is started with the Invitatory Psalm, traditionally Psalm 95. Prior to the reciting of the Psalm, the verse "Lord, open my lips. And my mouth will proclaim your praise." They are words so fitting for a disciple of Christ to begin the day with.

Morning Prayer and Evening Prayer are best intended for communal prayer, and the 85 Psalms spread through the 4 week cycle are those best fit for communal prayer. Most of the rest of the Psalms are incorporated into the minor hours and Office of Readings, so that if one were to prayer all the hours in a 4 week span, one would pray almost every one of the 150 Psalms.

The true beauty of praying the Psalms, whether by oneself or with others, is feeling the ebb and flow of the days and weeks and seasons as they pass by. I am reminded that every Friday Psalm 51 is prayed during morning prayer. What was once challenging prayer is now something I look forward to, and a reminder of another sacrifice, on a hill far away, and the love that poured forth from it.

Psalm 51 17-19

Lord, open my lips;

and my mouth shall declare your praise.

For in sacrifice you take no delight,

a burnt offering from me you would refuse,

my sacrifice, a contrite spirit.

A humbled, contrite heart, you will not spurn.

A small group of people gather each Thursday morning to pray Morning Prayer at 10:00AM. We invite you to join us and begin the day humbly with the Lord.
