

Wasting Time with God: Liturgical Prayer and Personal Prayer

Welcome friends to our discussion on prayer in our lives. I mentioned last weekend at Mass that I would begin with a discussion of Personal and Liturgical Prayer. Often time when talking about to different things, and speaking of their similarities and differences, it can be tempting to use the word "versus". This would be very problematic in speaking about personal and liturgical prayer, because to be well formed disciples of Jesus, we need both.

Starting with Liturgical prayer, it probably helps to define the word *Liturgy*, which means "work of the people". In general you can think of it as the official public worship of God gathered as the Body of Christ. The most familiar example is Eucharist. We know when we gather for Eucharist there is a formality to the worship along with structure and order. The roles are shared with the community, and we are led by an ordained minister. Liturgy of the Hours and the celebration of the other Sacraments are additional examples of Liturgical Prayer.

On the weekend, I used the phrase *devotional* prayer, but on further reflection the word is a bit too limiting. The other type of prayer is *personal* because that is what it is at the core. Even if celebrated with others, its focus is personal, God and us. Personal prayer is more subjective, and lends itself to adaptation to the individual. Meditation, contemplation, Lectio Divina, devotional prayers like the rosary, journaling, and Eucharistic Adoration are all forms of personal prayer that help us to draw into deeper personal relationship with God. God already has the relationship with us, personal prayer helps us become aware of it.

These two rich traditions complement each other, and work together to lift our hearts and minds to God. A rich prayer life, in both the public prayer of Liturgy and in the intimate personal prayer, we are drawn closer to God. May we all grow closer to God so that with child-like adoration we cry "Abba, father", that we readily rest our head on Jesus's breast as did the beloved disciple, and may we feel the gentle breath of the Holy Spirit on our faces.
