Funerals: Please contact us before or after contacting the funeral home.





### THE FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Friends in Christ,

The first paragraph in the introduction of the liturgical text for The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults begins as follows.

"1. The rite of Christian initiation presented here is designed for adults who, after hearing the mystery of Christ proclaimed, consciously and freely seek the living God and enter the way of faith and conversion as the Holy Spirit opens their hearts. By God's help they will be strengthened spiritually during their preparation and at the proper time will receive the sacraments fruitfully." - *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults* 

When we talk about RCIA, it is easy to fall into the trap of looking at it as a program or class. It is at it core a spiritual journey, that is supported by liturgy and community. As such, perfectly realized, it should never have a start date or a rigid schedule, because the primary catechist is the Holy Spirit. We should never stop inviting or walking with those who journey towards God in the sacraments.

Please be on the lookout for those at the threshold, seeking to draw closer to God. Hold the door open and invite them in. Support them as they wrestle with life's great mysteries, especially the life, passion, death, resurrection and ascension of Jesus Christ. If you know anyone seeking the Lord, please introduce them to me and to Fr. Fred. Together let each and every one of us support inquirers, catechumens and the Elect everywhere and at all times.
