Funerals: Please contact us before or after contacting the funeral home.





Continuing to move forward in "re-opening" and more familiar experiences, I wanted to update you on a few upcoming items. In consultation with the Diocese and the Central Michigan Health Department, we are able to have meals and events again. I met with some of the funeral luncheon people last week and they are prepared to start offering luncheons as requested. Your help is needed. If you have been a volunteer in the past, or would like to help with either providing food or helping to serve, please contact Joyce Feltman so we have up to date information.

Speaking with Marcia Griffin, we are looking to begin our Coffee & Donuts following Mass in September. In the summer it was always hit or miss on attendance, so the 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> of September will be our kickoff. This will coincide with our Mission Co-Op weekend where we will hear from and support Franciscan Works – Liberia Mission. This is a great opportunity to chat with the speakers more after Mass.

Finally some very important information regarding for those who use or are interested in online giving. Effective the end of July we will be terminating our usage of Our Sunday Visitor Online Giving and Switching to ShelbyNext Giving. ShelbyNext is the church management software we utilize in the office for pretty much everything. Making the switch will benefit the parish in seamless operation of gift tracking, better rates on fees and simplifying the work of the bookkeeper.

If you are a current user of OSV online giving, we ask that you log into your account and pause then cancel any and all recurring gifts, and delete any payment methods you have on file. Afterward you can move over to ShelbyNext and set up a recurring gift, which will have lower fees for the Parish and simpler office tracking. You can start this transition to ShelbyNext right now, and please note, no gifts will be processed through OSV after July.

Thank you once again for your continued support of St. Vincent de Paul Parish. Finance Council will meet soon to evaluate the past year, and provide a report of last year's finances, which appear good overall.
