

Christ's Mission Appeal 2021 has begun, and we are thankful for your continued support of St. Vincent de Paul Parish and the Diocese of Saginaw. As I mentioned last week, our goal for 2021 is \$53,308. This represents a 14% increase over last year.

I would like to see the campaign wrapped up by Thanksgiving this year, with everyone either pledged or paid for their allotment. As an incentive we are going to have a drawing for a few prizes for everyone who meets the deadline. The details are as follows.
