Dear Friends in Christ,

Christ’s Mission Appeal 2021 has begun, and we are thankful for your continued support of St. Vincent de Paul Parish and the Diocese of Saginaw. As I mentioned last week, our goal for 2021 is \$53,308. This represents a 14% increase over last year.

I would like to see the campaign wrapped up by Thanksgiving this year, with everyone either pledged or paid for their allotment. As an incentive we are going to have a drawing for a few prizes for everyone who meets the deadline. The details are as follows.

Everyone who pledges or donates to Christ’s Mission Appeal by the last Sunday of the liturgical year, Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, November 21st will be entered in the drawing. Additionally each giver that increases their giving over last year, will have their name entered a second time in the drawing. While there is no minimum increase, please note the parish’s goal is 14% higher this year.

If a name is drawn again and the person is present they will have the choice of prizes. If not present they receive the higher ranked prize, and another name is drawn for the lesser prize.
