Dear Friends in Christ,

You have probably noticed the calendar in the bulletin for the upcoming Novena for Life which will be prayed throughout the Diocese of Saginaw beginning next Friday. St. Vincent de Paul will host the 2nd evening Livestream for this Novena on Saturday, January 22^{nd,} at 6:30. Members of our local Knights of Columbus will lead the Novena prayer, followed by the entire community prayer Evening Prayer. As our parish is the host for this Livestream, your help is needed in attending this event and lending your voice in prayer. We have Coffee and Donuts that weekend, so feel free to pop over to the hall for a sugar and caffeine boost and then return for the Novena and Evening prayer. The prayer should take about 30 minutes.

In October 2021, Pope Francis called the entire Church into a Synod entitled: "For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, and Mission." Pope Francis asks all the People of God to journey together in dialogue and discernment, guided by the Holy Spirit. I am pleased to let you know that Cathy Converse accepted the Parish Group Coordinator's role. In upcoming bulletins, you will find more information and handouts regarding the Synod, including questions for personal reflection. This information will all lead to our preparation for the listening sessions at Saint Vincent de Paul.

I leave you with the prayer for the Synod, adapted from the prayer used for the sessions of the Vatican II Council.

- We stand before You, Holy Spirit, as we gather together in Your name.
- With You alone to guide us, make Yourself at home in our hearts;
- * Teach us the way we must go and how we are to pursue it.
- * We are weak and sinful; do not let us promote disorder.
- * Do not let ignorance lead us down the wrong path nor partiality influence our actions.
- * Let us find in You our unity so that we may journey together to eternal life and not stray from the way of truth and what is right.
- All this we ask of You, who are at work in every place and time, in the communion of the Father and the Son, forever and ever.
- * Amen.
