First Fridays with Bishop Robert Gruss... returned to the Cathedral Fri., Jan. 7, nearly 2 years after a break caused by Covid. When he shared how wonderful it was to be gathered again, the more than 100 members of the faith community present responded with applause.

"It's good to get back," Bishop Gruss agreed "But don't let your guard down. Get vaccinated. I've been vaxxed and boosted and I encourage others to as well. I'm told that 80 percent of those in ICU and on ventilators in our hospitals are not vaccinated."

The next First Friday with the Bishop is Feb. 4 at 11am. It begins with Mass in the Cathedral and continues in the lower level of the Cathedral with a meatless lunch and informal presentation.

THE FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Friends in Christ,

This week's teaching on the Mass is about "The Full, Conscious, and Active Participation of the Assembly." I spent some time reading the handout, and I am eager to hear what Fr. Fred has to say. The first line in the fifth paragraph; "For centuries, the faithful "attended" or "heard" Mass in Latin.", really stands out to me. It reminds me of an old phrase we still misuse today.

The phrase "Father said Mass today" really misses the point of our gathering. The priest does not say Mass, they preside or celebrate. Not only does it miss the mark on the participation of the assembly, but it also ignores the riches of the liturgy itself. The entire liturgy engages not only the ears but the other senses as well. Sacred liturgy nourishes and uplifts the mind, body, and soul. It is marked by postures and gestures, sights and sounds that are all significant and point to the reality of the liturgy.

I won't steal any more from Fr. Fred. But I will invite you today and every day to put your full self into the liturgy in the worship of our loving God, who gave us our full self anyway.
