called by Pope Francis. I want to start with a couple of excerpts from Bishop Gruss' homily from the opening Mass of the "Synod on Synodality."

"What is a Synod? It is an ancient word in the Tradition of the Church whose meaning indicates the path along which the People of God walk together. It also refers to the Lord Jesus and to the fact that Christians, His followers, were originally called "followers of the way."

On one of the vital pillars of a synodal Church, participation, Bishop Gruss had this to say.

"A call for the involvement of all who belong to the People of God – laity, consecrated and ordained – to engage in the exercise of deep and respectful listening to one another. This listening creates space for us to hear the Holy Spirit together, and guides our aspirations for the Church of the Third Millennium."

I missed you all last weekend, but I was so thankful that Erin and I could be with our son as his collegiate swim career came to a close.
