Our Catholic Tradition

On Sunday, March 6, faithful from parishes throughout the diocese gathered for the Rite of Election, which was presided over by Bishop Robert Gruss at the Cathedral of Mary of the Assumption in Saginaw.

Each year, generally on the First Sunday of Lent, the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults [RCIA] celebrates the "election" of those catechumens who have been deemed by parish leadership to be appropriately prepared to receive the Easter sacraments.

As a result of this rite, these catechumens, who will be fully initiated at the upcoming Easter Vigil, are called our "elect" (meaning those who have been "chosen").

During the liturgical rite, sponsors give witness to the bishop that the "chosen" catechumens are worthy and appropriately prepared for the Easter sacraments. As part of the Rite of Election, the names of the elect are added to the Book of the Elect.
