#### Are You Grieving?

Our Parish will again offer a Grief Recovery group, six weekly meetings providing support and education. It starts Monday, March 14 and runs through Monday, April 18. The time will be determined by those who sign up.

We've offered this several times in the last few years. You may know someone who attended.

This group is for anyone who has suffered the death of a significant person in their life;: a spouse, child, parent, sibling or close friend. The loss may be recent or some time ago. All of us experience the death of someone close to us at some time.

The church knows that grief is a normal response to loss. As well as practical help, the church offers spiritual and emotional support through prayer, and individual and group experiences of listening and learning such as Grief Recovery.

Grief Recovery has been developed by our Diocese and group facilitators are trained by them. Confidentiality is always kept.
