Christ is Risen; he is Risen indeed!

We gather this morning in the brilliant light of Christ's Resurrection from the dead. I write these words as we prepare to enter the Sacred Paschal Triduum.

On Holy Thursday, Christ gathers and eats with his disciples, and we celebrate the institution of the Eucharist. Christ's very Body and Blood, which will be offered up for our sins, and the sins of the world become our food for life and the source and the summit of our faith.

On Good Friday, Jesus says yes to the Father's will and becomes the unblemished lamb whose sacrifice once and for all is offered up. The cross, an instrument of torture and death, will be forever changed into the symbol of our salvation upon His rising from the dead.

We gather in the darkness on the Easter Vigil to celebrate the glorious light of the resurrected Christ entering the world. The bright light of the Vigil fire that breaks the darkness of the night is just a glimmer of the light that Christ brings into this world and shares with each of us.

I pray you to have a joyful Easter season, and may God bless you abundantly.
