Funerals: Please contact us before or after contacting the funeral home.





Bishop Gruss invites you to encounter Christ in the celebration of Mass for the Body and Blood of Christ next weekend, June 18 & 19. The pandemic has created for many a heartbreaking separation from the Body & Blood of Christ—who can heal us in mind, body and spirit.

Next weekend we'll be reminded that Christ wants nothing more than to be united with us. We'll be reminded that his passion, death and resurrection revealed to us that God gave his only beloved son for our salvation.

If you have been away for a while, please come. The Lord Jesus has been waiting patiently.

Over the course of the next couple of years, you are encouraged to encounter the Risen Christ in all the ways he is present to us in the Mass: the sacrament of the Body and Blood of Christ, the assembly of God's people, the sacred Word of God proclaimed, and the celebrant.
