THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

Dear Friends in Christ, the Eucharist is the Source and Summit of our faith and an unsurpassable sign of our unity in Christ. We celebrate this gift of grace in a special way on this Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ and I share with you this special announcement from Bishop Gruss.

Bishop Gruss is granting permission to return the practice of offering the Distribution of the Precious Blood of the Risen Lord at Mass with the upcoming celebration of the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ on Sunday, June 19, 2022. The General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM) states: "Holy Communion has a fuller form as a sign when it takes place under both kinds. For in this form the sign of the Eucharistic banquet is more clearly evident." (#281). Therefore, St. Vincent de Paul Parish will return to offering the Precious Blood at Communion time for those who desire to receive on The Nineteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time, August 7th -- after the necessary instructions to our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and the appropriate liturgical catechesis for our community. Please remember that reception of the Precious Blood of the Lord from the Chalice remains an option. The act of receiving Holy Communion is an act of faith. The person makes this act of faith in the total presence of the Lord whether in receiving Holy Communion under one form or under both kinds. (#14-15 - Norms for the Distribution of Holy Communion Under Both Kinds).

Participation of all the faithful in the reception of Holy Communion Under Both Kinds is one of the most significant post-council changes and restoration of the practice of the first 12 Centuries of the church.

"Take this, all of you, and drink from it, for this is the chalice of my Blood."

Throughout the month of July will we have several opportunities for the formation of our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion as well as teachings at Mass on the proper reception of the Eucharist. I have spent the last 27 months looking at the reflections in the Chalice, and I long to receive Christ's Most Precious Blood with you all once again.

SAGINAW — The Most Rev. Robert D. Gruss has appointed Deacon Stanley Kuczynski to be Director of the Permanent Diaconate for the Diocese of Saginaw. The appointment is for three years beginning July 1, 2022.

Deacon Kuczynski brings years of parish experience and a unique background to his new role. A native of Poland, Deacon Kuczynski spent some time in seminary formation in his homeland and received a Master's degree in theology with a specialization in musicology from the Cardinal Stefan Wyszynski University in Warsaw.

After being ordained a permanent deacon by Bishop Joseph R. Cistone on June 5, 2011, he served at St. Stanislaus Parish and then Our Lady of Czestochowa Parish in Bay City. Along the way, he has received invaluable support in his ministry from his wife, Małgorzata (Margaret), and his three sons.

"I am very pleased to have Deacon Stanley in this new role," said Bishop Gruss. "With his gifts and experience as a deacon, he will be a great asset to the diocese and the deacon community."

Deacon Kuczynski added: "In this role, I hope to live even more deeply the diaconal charism by serving my brother deacons and their families – as well as supporting the Permanent Deacon Formation Program in our diocese."

As Director, Deacon Kuczynski will work closely with Dr. Dan Osborn, Coordinator of Permanent Diaconate Formation & Ministry. "I look forward to Deacon Stanley serving as director. We have collaborated in the past and I found him to be a dedicated deacon who finds joy in serving," Dr. Osborn noted.
