Funerals: Please contact us before or after contacting the funeral home.





Dear Friends in Christ,

It is June 1, 2022, as I write to you today, and it is the 4th anniversary of my appointment as Pastoral Administrator here at St. Vincent de Paul. I was nervous and excited when I received the appointment from Bishop Cistone, but I had no idea I would be so well supported by such a loving parish community.

Together we have faced challenges and setbacks, but also great successes and joys. Through it all, this parish community has worked to be a welcoming place where all are welcome to gather around the table of the Lord and worship together. I am honored to be a part of St. Vincent de Paul Parish.

In two weeks the Church the world over will celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Here in the United States, this will also be the launch of a 2-year Eucharistic Revival. Two years of special attention to the celebration of the Eucharist and what this means in our lives of faith.

These past four years together have been in preparation for this time. Time for us to recognize that Christ calls us all to the table to worship, calls us all to receive Him in communion, and that it is Jesus who is fully present in the Eucharistic species. "In brief, the Eucharist is the sum and summary of our faith:" our way of thinking is attuned to the Eucharist, and the Eucharist in turn confirms our way of thinking." (CCC1327)

I look forward to delving deeper into the mystery of the Eucharist with you all.
