Dear Friends in Christ,

We celebrated the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ two weeks ago. On Sunday, I had the opportunity to participate in the Eucharistic Revival kick-off Mass with Bishop Gruss. That Mass saw the return of the distribution of the Precious Blood and concluded with a Eucharistic Procession around the perimeter of the Cathedral Campus. I, along with seminarian Andy Cipolla, lead Bishop Gruss and the Eucharist with smoking thuribles, constantly being re-filled by Fr. Bill Rutkowski. It was a pleasure to see traffic stop and wait for the Eucharist to pass before resuming.

As I was at YES, I got a phone call that I was cleared once again to take communion to the imprisoned. The absence of this ministry has been very hard for me, as taking communion to those unable to come to the Eucharist on their own was one of the most rewarding ministries. As we work toward returning to the reception of Christ's Precious Blood, we must also work on inviting back those who have been away, as well as taking communion to those unable to join us at the table.
