### THE EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Our first Livestream event from the parish was Night Prayer on Wednesday, March 18<sup>th</sup>, 2020. A few weeks later, we Livestreamed Mass for the first time on Palm Sunday that year. Fr. Fred, Mary, Joshua, and I were gathered in a very lonely church to celebrate the liturgy that brings us together. A few weeks later, we added Steve to the team so Joshua did not have to simultaneously sing and run a computer.

Live streaming has been a part of the liturgical celebration at St. Vincent de Paul Parish throughout our dealing with the pandemic. It has been a crutch to keep us united throughout this time. But a crutch is a tool we hope to move past, and its time has come. With the return of the reception of the Precious Blood next weekend, we are past all major liturgical adaptations to the celebration of Mass. We can gather fully at the table of the Lord.

After much prayer, thought, and consultation, we will stop live streaming Sunday Masses. Our last Livestream will be on Sunday, August 21st.

Our Mass celebration reaches its summit at the celebration of the Eucharist and our receiving of Jesus fully and completely in his Body and Blood. Our greatest desire is for all of us to gather together and walk towards the Altar of the Lord every Sunday. We will make arrangements to bring the Eucharist to you at home, for the Body of Christ cares for the Body of Christ, and no encounter with Jesus is more intimate or precious than receiving his Body and Blood.
