Funerals: Please contact us before or after contacting the funeral home.





Dear Friends in Christ,

I write to you today in the midst of Marvelous Mystery VBS, where over 40 children from St. Vincent de Paul and Nativity of the Lord gather each day to learn more about the Eucharist and the Celebration of the Mass. So far, they have learned about the Mass as a Mystery, a Gift, and a Celebration. They have also learned about the virtues of Patience, Peace, and today, Unity.

This virtue of Unity is critical to the celebration of Mass. We discussed this morning that when we go to a friend's birthday party, we do it not to get something, but to celebrate our friend. The same for coming to Mass; we gather to celebrate Jesus and his sacrifice and to do it united together. Isn't the celebration of Mass so much better when our voices, bodies, and hearts are united in Christ?

We have great musical talent in the parish, but it is much more meaningful to me when their leading blends into a symphony of all our voices singing together.

Fr. Fred is one of the most gifted presiders I have ever been with, but the way he guides us into praying The Lord's Prayer, the Creed, and all the other communal prayers so that no one voice stands alone is a rare talent.

When we stand, sit, bow, and kneel together so that not only are our hearts united but our bodies as well, we visually see our common Unity in Christ.

Exhibiting this Unity is a critical component of being a parish together. It supports parents, and parents support their children in practicing this active participation in the Mass.
