Dear Friends in Christ,

Between last week's Gospel and this week's, there is a section of about ten verses that focuses on our dependence upon God. Remember that last week we heard that the land produced a bountiful harvest that the Rich Man was so concerned over.

The verse "There was a rich man whose land produced a bountiful harvest" is a none-too-subtle reminder that all we have originates in God's wonderous creation. Verses 22-31 explain how God cares for all of creation, and even the ravens of the air who lack a storehouse for grain are fed. When we claim ownership of and disordered care for what we have, we lose the focus of creation as a wonderful gift.

This week's Gospel makes firm the comments from last week's homily that we edge toward idolatry with our love of things. "For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be." Is our heart with God, or is our heart with our things?

Christian Meditation teacher and Benedictine Monk, Fr. Laurence Freemen, in teaching on attention in meditation, explains that we pay attention to that which we love. When our heart is focused correctly on God, we see God as the owner of all things, and our stewardship of the world in all things becomes appropriately ordered.
