Meeting Minutes- August 9, 2022

The Pastoral Council (PC) meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Kaylie Willoughby. Deacon Todd led the opening prayer. Roll call was completed by Jackie Loomis. A motion was made by Dave Spindler and seconded by Tim Sieracki to approve the June 14, 2022 Pastoral Council Meeting Minutes; motion passed.

Old Business:

Building and Maintenance Updates: The committee continues to review the bids for the boilers and hot water heaters. Deacon Todd would like to get quotes with the same specifications for a better comparison. The replacement of the light bulbs with LED bulbs is an ongoing project.

Christ Mission Appeal: We are currently \$188.16 over our target. This will increase to \$1,281.86 if all pledged donations are received.

Parish Directory: We are scheduled to have pictures taken September 13-17th. Liz stated that the signup is going well. Allison Catrell will be designing the directory.

New Business:

Christ Mission Appeal (2022-2023): Deacon Todd anticipates that our goal will increase. The Appeal should be starting sometime in October.

Parish Mission/Rise Against Hunger: The Rise Against Hunger is tentatively planned for October 12th. Twenty thousand (20,000) meals will be bagged at this event. Approximately 100 volunteers will be needed.

Summer Outdoor Mass/Parish Picnic/Golf Outing (August 27 & 28): The golf outing is Saturday, August 27th. A donation of \$250 was made for a person that makes a hole in one. If a hole in one isn't made, the money will be donated to SVDP. The Outdoor Mass will be held on Sunday, August 28th. Steve Roth is providing speakers for the outdoor mass. Jay Travis will be providing tents and tables.

Faith Formation: Vacation Bible School is going great. Participants are from the Alma and Shepherd area. Deacon Todd is looking at ideas for adult faith formation for this year.

Purifying Vessels: Deacon Todd will be contacting the Diocese to see if someone else can purify the vessels in his absence at mass.

Holly Jolly Christmas Parade: The parade is November 30th. Deacon Todd will share more information in the bulletin. We are looking for someone to coordinate a float/trailer in the parade. We are hosting a baked potato bar like last year. We are going to look into a brass quintet to be playing in the social hall.

Our next Pastoral Council meeting is scheduled on Tuesday, October 18th at 6:00 p.m. This will be a joint meeting with the Finance Council.

Deacon Todd led the closing prayer. The meeting concluded at 7:00 p.m.
