Hospitalized/Homebound Ministry: Please call the office to arrange for Eucharist or for a pastoral visit.



Safe Environment (VIRTUS) Policy Updates

Safe Environment training and a criminal history background check is required for all employees and for volunteers who have contact with minors in parishes, schools and diocesan events.

One of the most significant changes in the policy is the definition of *contact with minors*. *Contact with minors* is defined as in-person or virtual presence by Personnel with minor(s) for which there is a responsibility, including but not limited to, a chaperone, catechist, hall monitor, classroom volunteer, usher or music director.

Effective date is January 1, 2023. Additional policy information will be provided weekly.
