Hospitalized/Homebound Ministry: Please call the office to arrange for Eucharist or for a pastoral visit.



This weekend we are coming off our celebration of the National holiday Thanksgiving. Families mark the holiday in many ways, sometimes full of long-standing traditions. For those in charge of the food for the day, it generally isn't a day-long event but the culmination of days and perhaps weeks of preparation.

So it is fitting that we enter into the Advent season following Thanksgiving. We have taken time to be thankful for family and friends, a roof over our heads, and a warm bed to settle into at night. Now we come together as a broader family, the family of Christ, to prepare for a season of thanksgiving at Christmas. We celebrate the birth of Christ not just for a day but for two whole weeks. We give thanks for the fulfillment of the words of Isaiah we hear on Christmas Eve.

For a child is born to us, a son is given to us; upon his shoulder dominion rests.

They name him Wonder-Counselor, God-Hero, Father-Forever, Prince of Peace.

Preparation for a celebration of this magnitude takes time. Four whole weeks of preparing and listening to the scriptures that foretell Christ's coming and his coming again. Setting aside the Gloria so that when it returns at Christmas, all our voices together indeed sound like the choir of angels that join with us. Using the Confiteor during the penitential season reminds us of our need for a savior and our responsibility to pray for one another.

Let us then enter this season with a heart ready to be molded in preparation for the grand celebration to come.
