Dear Friends in Christ,

This Tuesday, December 13th, we will celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation at a Communal Penance Service at 6:00 PM. Fr. Fred Thelen, Fr. Loren Kalinowski, and Fr. Paul Werley will be present with our own Fr. Fred to hear our individual confessions.

Before and after that moment of individual confession and absolution, we will pray communally. Beforehand, we will listen to God's mercy proclaimed in sacred scripture, confess our general sinfulness together, and ask for God's mercy. After our confessions, everyone is invited to remain in the church. When all have been absolved of their sins, we will sing a hymn of praise to God's mercy, pray in thanksgiving for that gift, and be sent forth in Peace.

Why do we choose to remain afterward? The Rite of Penance reminds us, "Penance always therefore entails reconciliation with our brethren and sisters who remain harmed by our sins." Seldom does harm caused by our sin remain only between God and us. Penance also heals the Body of Christ, the Church. This celebration of thanksgiving in God's mercy is also a liturgical mirror to Chapter 15 of Luke's Gospel, verse 7, "... in the same way there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous people who have no need of repentance."

So my dear friends, avail yourselves of this beautiful experience of God's mercy and compassion at 6:00 PM on Tuesday, Dec 13th. To facilitate the liturgy occurring around dinner time, we will serve a straightforward soup supper with two choices of soup, from 5:00- 5:45 pm, in the Parish Social Hall.
