Marriage: Contact parish office no less than six months prior to wedding date.


Sacrament of Anointing of Sick: Please contact us before a surgery, during hospitalization or if experiencing a change in health.

Our diocese was established on Feb. 26, 1938, by Pope Pius XI with the appointment of William J. Murphy as our 1st Bishop. Bishop Murphy chose Saint Mary Church as the new Cathedral. Its territory included 16 counties, carved out the Diocese of Grand Rapids and the Archdiocese of Detroit.
