Marriage: Contact parish office no less than six months prior to wedding date.


Sacrament of Anointing of Sick: Please contact us before a surgery, during hospitalization or if experiencing a change in health.

Dear Friends in Christ,

Christ is risen; He is risen indeed.

I am writing to you on the eve of the Triduum, thinking ahead to the joy of Easter. As I sit here, thinking of all the great moments we will experience together liturgically, it is easy to get overwhelmed. The humility of washing feet, the joy of remembering the institution of the Eucharist. The journey to the Garden of Gethsemane, the disciples fleeing, and Peter's denial. The trial, the crowds, and the shouts of "Crucify him, crucify him." The crown and the nails. Embracing the cross: an instrument of death and the Tree of Life. Gathering in the darkness and finding the light of our life in the empty tomb.

So much of our faith lies within this complex duality. We are people in need of salvation, yet in Christ's saving action, we have been saved. The crucifix at Holy Spirit Church in Shields has a corpus resembling the crucified Christ and the risen Christ breaking free of the cross. The cross has a hole in the center, reminding the viewer that we pass through the cross. We live as people on both sides of the cross. On the crucified side, not in despair, but in realizing the Joy of the Resurrection. On the risen side, always remembering our need for the saving grace of Jesus Christ, who suffered, died, and rose again for me.

This is the joy of Easter, happily joining in all that the life of discipleship calls us to be and do. So we go forth, kneeling joyfully at Christ's feet and rising to serve at table. We quietly go to our inner room to encounter God and join our voices in praising the King. We humbly wash others' feet and boldly proclaim the Gospel.
