

Dear Friends in Christ,

Last weekend while we were away, Erin and I had the privilege of attending Mass at St. Barbara Church in Black Diamond, WA. It was a bright and airy church, and we were surprised to find it laid out in a choir style, like the Archabbey Church at Saint Meinrad where I attend school. The baptismal font, ambo, and presider's chair were at one end of the length of the church. The Altar and choir area was at the other end. All the pews faced inward to the long axis. It would be quite the experience to have this as a regular place of worship. The front of the church puts you close to the activity, but here, you are close to the ambo, or altar, never both.

We chose this church, which was not the closest to the place we were staying because I noticed online that they had restored the reception of the Precious Blood. While I know theologically Christ's Body and Blood are both fully present in each species, I cannot help but be drawn to the words of institution the Priest prays at every Mass.

"Take this, all of you, and drink from it, / for this is the chalice of my Blood, / the Blood of the new and eternal covenant, / which will be poured out for you and for many / for the forgiveness of sins. Do this in memory of me."

As a Deacon, I am not simply an Ordinary Minister of Holy Communion. Deacons are Ordinary Ministers of the Precious Blood. The words of Christ that Fr. Fred prays are precious to me. Reception under both species of the Eucharist concretely reminds me that Christ's Body was sacrificed for me and that I am washed clean in His Blood.
