On Wednesday this past week we wrapped up our joint VBS with Nativity of the Lord Parish.. Some 40 youth and dozens of volunteers came together for an awesome experience. It was a space setting called Stellar, with the overarching theme of "Shine Jesus' Light." Each day's Bible Point provided a different occasion to "Shine Jesus' Light."

Day 1: When life seems dark...shine Jesus' light!

Day 2: When people don't get along... shine Jesus' light!

Day 3: When good things happen... shine Jesus' light!

The first two points are obvious to all of us. We turn to Jesus in times of our need or attempt to be there for others who are struggling. But I think we sometimes miss that third point. It can be easy when things are going well to overlook the blessings of God in our lives. I know that I fall into this trap from time to time. But an important type of prayer is a prayer of thanksgiving. The word eucharist means thanksgiving.
