Dear Friends in Christ.

Last weekend in his homily Fr. Fred began with call and response, and then he concluded with discussion of vocations as an outcome of call and response with God. He and I both share a common vocation to Holy Order, though different in degree. Erin and I share the vocation of married life and there are many parishioner who share the vocation of generous single life. Sister Marie Kopin who has recently joined our choir lives out the vocation to religious life. These are the 'classical' vocations that the church speaks about - Holy Orders, Religious Life, Married Life, Generous Single Life.

The interesting thing about these vocations is that they are only a small facet of the total view of the word Vocation. The word vocation is used 55 times in the Catechism of the Catholic Church, and few of them relate directly to Holy Order, Religious Life, etc. The definition of the word vocation in the Catechism begins "The calling or destiny we have in this life and hereafter. God has created the human person to love and serve him; the fulfilment of this vocation is eternal happiness." Some uses of the word in the Catechism include.

> "The vocation of humanity is to show forth the image of God..." CCC #1877

"...the common vocation of all Christ's disciples, a vocation to holiness and to the mission of evangelizing the world." CCC #1533

"Society should permit each of its members to fulfill his vocation. In particular, the common good resides in the conditions for the exercise of the natural freedoms indispensable for the development of the human vocation." CCC # 1907

"They should encourage them in the vocation, which is proper to each child, fostering with special care any religious vocation." CCC #1656

Particularly noted in that last quote is that a religious vocation is preceded by a universal vocation. We will always struggle with religious vocations if we don't acknowledge the universal vocations on a personal, a family, a parish, and a diocesan level. The question, not just young people but for all of us, is not "What to I want to do with my life?" but rather "What is God calling me to do with the gifts that he has given me?"

This is not easy; it requires a surrender to God's will. But we must remember the end goal, for "the fulfilment of this vocation is eternal happiness."
