Dear Friends in Christ,

The great season of preparation, Lent, is upon us, and we ready ourselves to take up the three pillars of the season:
Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving. The Little Black Books are at the entryway of the church, helping us walk the path daily. Morning and Evening prayer sessions, Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Reconciliation, and the Rescue Project are all scheduled to help encounter Christ in a variety of ways.

In our Sunday celebrations, we will see changes as well, beyond the shifting from green to purple. This weekend, we say goodbye to the Gloria, along with the word Alleluia, which we will symbolically 'bury' at the end of Mass on Sunday. After this weekend, our music will be more subdued, in keeping with the season.

When the Worship Commission met a couple of weeks ago, we decided on a common Psalm for the season of Lent, with the refrain "Create in me a clean heart, O God" based on Psalm 51. The theme of Lent this year will be purification, which our Catechumen, Greg Krafft, will be experiencing in the Period of Purification and Enlightenment after the Rite of Election. We should always remember the purification we have received in Christ and our need to work to maintain it.

All this is to prepare our hearts to receive the Easter joy again on March 31st. I look forward to journeying with you.

REGULATIONS FOR FAST AND ABSTINENCE

Ash Wednesday, February 14, 2024, and Good Friday, March 29, 2024, are days of fasting and abstinence. All Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence.

† FASTING is to be observed by all 18 years of age and older who have not yet celebrated their 59th birthday. On a fast day one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and juices, are allowed.

† ABSTINENCE is observed by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence, no meat is allowed. Note that when health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. When in doubt concerning fasting and abstinence, one's pastor or director of parish life should be consulted.

- Ash Wednesday, February 14, 2024, and Good Friday, March 29, 2024, are days of fasting and abstinence. All the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence.
- Fasting, almsgiving, and prayer are the three traditional disciplines of Lent. The
 faithful, the Elect and those Candidates preparing for Reception into Full
 Communion in the Catholic Church should undertake these practices seriously in a
 spirit of penance and of preparation for baptism or of renewal of baptism at Easter.
