John & Marie Frost went to a church this week at the Cathedral of Christ the King, cathedral of the Diocese Reykjavik in Iceland.



On Sunday June 9, Ed and Marilyn Lorenz went with 3 of their grandkids to St Martin's Church in Oradour sur Glane in France. In addition to murdering every man in the village in the main plaza, the Gestapo put all the 450 women and children into the church and then burned them alive. France decided not to rebuild the village or its church but to leave it a perpetual memorial to the "martyred villages" of modern war.



We've moved south from Oradour sur Glane to Lourdes. There are two links to Oradour. First, on the wall of the church in Oradour, they have proclaimed by a cross on the outside wall that St. Bernadette and Our Lady of Lourdes still are inside their church.
