Fr. Dennis C. Callan SVD will be at **St. Vincent De Paul Parish on August 24-25, 2024** to celebrate Masses and speak about the many ministries of his religious community, Divine Word Missionaries. They are an international religious community of missionary priests and Brothers serving in 79 countries helping to build chapels, celebrate the sacraments and spread the Word of God in remote mission communities.

As a native of Philadelphia, Father Dennis has a rich and diverse background in international service. He spent 18 years in Taiwan and an additional 16 years in South Korea before returning to the United States in 2016.

During his time in Taiwan, Father Dennis held significant roles including formation director for the congregation's China Province and general affairs director at Fu Jen Catholic University. In Korea, he taught in the seminary at Suwon Catholic University, worked closely with migrant workers, served as a contract priest for the U.S. Army, and assumed the position of regional superior for Divine Word Missionaries.

Currently, Father Dennis serves as the superior delegate of the North American provinces, overseeing the care of Divine Word Missionaries from other countries who are visiting the United States. His proficiency in both Chinese and Korean languages has significantly enriched his capacity to effectively serve diverse communities.
