

This weekend is the 3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time. Since Jan 26, 2020 we have also celebrated it as the Sunday of the word of God. Pope Francis instituted this celebration in his apostolic letter *Aperut illis* "He opened it to them" taken from Luke's Gospel when Jesus opens the scriptures to the disciples on the road to Emmaus.

This day is to be "a Sunday given over entirely to the word of God so as to appreciate the inexhaustible riches contained in that constant dialogue between the Lord and his people." It is important for us to remember that sacred Scripture is not a dead, trapped in the past story, but rather, words from a loved one that challenge, comfort, instruct or illuminate in a new way whether we are hearing it first or 100th time.
