

Greetings, everyone. This message is a copy of part of a letter to parents of middle and high school youth in our parish.

I am sharing it here because A) I do not have every email address that I should, and B) you need to know how important this endeavor is and that it needs your prayers of support.

Parents, I know life and the world pulls you and your children in about a million different directions. I really want the church to support you and your children, not be a burden, and help guide them into a lifelong relationship with Christ.

For those of you who may remember, before stepping into my role as director of parish life here at Saint Vincent de Paul, I was the director of religious education and youth ministry at Nativity of the Lord parish. After prayer and trusting in the Lord, the next most significant source of support for a young person related to youth ministry is having at least one friend with them. Youth ministry works best when a critical mass of youth is present, and each young person has at least one other friend.

We will again post a job opening for a Youth Minister, but we cannot wait to see if our prayers are answered. Youth Ministry is integral to our sacramental formation and Confirmation going forward. Even if it were not, our young people need our support in this critical time in their lives.

I am trying to step forward into the role as best as possible. I know getting my schedule and the schedule of 15 to 20 active young people to all lineup is challenging, but I will not give up.

I want to gather on Sunday, February 23rd, after mass from ~11:30 to 1:00 p.m. If I have a head count, I can figure out a way to feed them after mass. Then, I would like to explore what they want and need in their lives. We will then work on a plan for an event on March 22nd in Bay City. This gathering will be for all in 6<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade.
