God our Father,

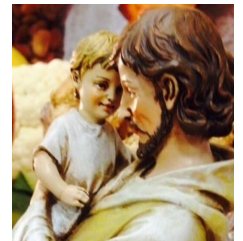
In your wisdom and love you have created us and called us your own. Bless our fathers, that they may be strengthened as Christian fathers.

You can also follow Saint Meinrad on Facebook. They livestream Mass (8:30 AM ET) and Vespers (6:00 PM ET). You might catch a glimpse of the pilgrims at Mass on Wednesday—Friday.

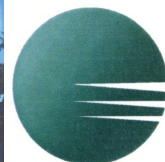
